charges:

COUNT 1

That ALBERT HAMLIN, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on or about the
6th day of January, 2010, at Providence, in the County of Providence, did unlawfully

possess with intent to deliver a controlled substance, to wit, the chemical equivalent of a preparation of coca leaves in a form known as cocaine, as set forth in Schedule II of §21-28-2.08 of the General Laws, as amended, in violation of §21-28-4.01(a)(4)(i) of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 2

That ALBERT HAMLIN, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on or about the 2nd day of March, 2010, at Providence, in the County of Providence, did unlawfully possess with intent to deliver a controlled substance, to wit, the chemical equivalent of a preparation of coca leaves in a form known as cocaine, as set forth in Schedule II of §21-28-2.08 of the General Laws, as amended, in violation of §21-28-4.01(a)(4)(i) of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 3

That ALBERT HAMLIN, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on or about the 4th day of March, 2010, at Providence, in the County of Providence, did unlawfully, with knowledge and intent possess a controlled substance, to wit, hydrocodone, as set forth in Schedule II of §21-28-2.08 of the General Laws, as amended, in violation of §21-28-4.01(c)(2)(i) of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 10

That ALBERT HAMLIN, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on or about the 24th day of February, 2010, at Providence, in the County of Providence, did unlawfully, with knowledge and intent possess a controlled substance, to wit, methandrostenolone

(DBOL), as set forth in Schedule III of §21-28-2.08 of the General Laws, as amended, in violation of §21-28-4.01(c)(2)(i) of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 11

That ALBERT HAMLIN, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on or about the 4th day of March, 2010, at Providence, in the County of Providence, did fraudulently receive stolen goods, chattels, and property, to wit, a sig sauer firearm, belonging to Joseph Cote, knowing the same to be stolen, in violation of §11-41-2 and §11-41-5 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 12

That ALBERT HAMLIN, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on or about the 12th day of November, 2009, at North Providence, in the County of Providence, did falsely assume or pretend to be a police officer of a city or town in this State and did act as such, in violation of §11-14-1 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 13

That ALBERT HAMLIN, alias John Doe, of Providence County, and KHALID MASON, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on or about the 4th day of March, 2010, at Providence, in the County of Providence, did unlawfully conspire to violate the Rhode Island Uniform Controlled Substances Act by agreeing to the unlawful possession of a certain enumerated quantity of a controlled substance, to wit, one (1) ounce to one (1) kilogram of cocaine, as set forth in Schedule II of §21-28-2.08 of the General Laws, as

amended, in violation of §21-28-4.08 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 14

That JOSEPH COLANDUONO, alias John Doe, of Kent County, on or about the 24th day of February, 2010, at Providence, in the County of Providence, knowing that a crime had been committed and while not actively assisting the offender or assenting thereto, did criminally neglect to bring the offender to justice by concealing or keeping secret the commission of a felony possession of a controlled substance, to wit, methandrostenolone (DBOL), in violation of §11-1-1 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 25

That JOSEPH COLANDUONO, alias John Doe, of Kent County, and ROBERT ENRIGHT, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on a day and date between the 12th day of November, 2009 and the 17th day of November, 2009, in the State of Rhode Island, knowing that Albert Hamlin committed the crime and offense of impersonating a

police officer and not standing in the relation of husband or wife, parent or grandparent, child or grandchild, or brother or sister, by consanguinity or affinity, did knowingly harbor or relieve Albert Hamlin to avoid detection, arrest, trial, or punishment, in violation of §11-1-4 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 26

That JOSEPH COLANDUONO, alias John Doe, of Kent County, and ROBERT ENRIGHT, alias John Doe, of Providence County, on a day and date between the 12th day of November, 2009 and the 17th day of November, 2009, in the State of Rhode Island, did agree, combine, confederate, contrive or conspire together to do an unlawful act(s), to wit, harbor or relieve Albert Hamlin to avoid detection, arrest, trial, or punishment, in violation of §11-1-6 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended (Reenactment of 2002).

COUNT 27


