COUNT ONE

1. On or about April 12, 2006, in the District of Rhode Island and elsewhere, the defendant,

ANTHONY M. ST. LAURENT, SR.,

with intent that another person engage in conduct constituting a felony that has as an element the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical force against the person of another in violation of the laws of the United States, and under circumstances strongly corroborative of that intent, did solicit, command, induce and otherwise endeavor to persuade such other person to engage in such conduct, that is, to travel and cause another to travel in interstate commerce and use and cause another to use a facility of interstate commerce with intent that a murder be committed in violation of the laws of the state of Rhode Island as consideration for the receipt of or for a promise or agreement to pay anything of pecuniary value, in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1958.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 373 (solicitation to commit a crime of violence).

COUNT TWO

2. On or about April 12, 2006, in the District of Rhode Island and elsewhere, the defendant,

ANTHONY M. ST. LAURENT, SR.,


did travel and cause another to travel in interstate commerce, and did use and cause another to use a facility of interstate commerce, that is, communication by telephone and cellular telephone, with intent that murder be committed in violation of the laws of the state of Rhode Island as consideration for the receipt of or for a promise or agreement to pay, anything of pecuniary value.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1958 (use of interstate commerce facilities in the commission of murder-for-hire).
